He has authored/ coauthored about 20 technical articles in different national & international seminars/ conferences, delivered various lectures in different training/ workshops, edited different journals and has written a book (manuscript), "Pubottaranjali", which is a collection of technical articles, mostly on North-Eastern part of the country in Hindi. His major areas of works include setting up policy initiatives, planning, design and financing of water resources projects. He has been involved in implementation of Command Area Development and water Management (CADWM) Programme for more than 10 years and guided its implementation, as Commissioner, for five years, in the country. He, in his long-distinguished service encompassing all aspects of water resources sector, has provided effective leadership to the large water resources professionals towards water resources development and management in the entire country.
